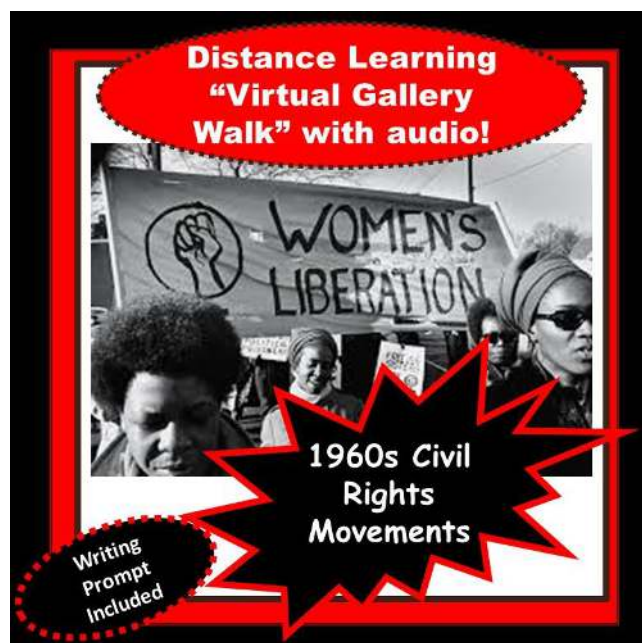
Usage Guide:

Eisenhower -- U.S. President from 1953-1961

Baby boom -- Increase in childbearing occurring after World War II

Korean War -- Military Conflict fought 1950-1953

Rosenbergs -- Ethel and Julian, married couple, executed for spying for Soviet Union

Nikita Khrushchev -- Became leader of Soviet Union after Stalin died

Rosa Parks -- Black civil rights leader, including starting Montgomery bus boycott

Linda Brown -- Lead plaintiff in Supreme Court case that desegregated public education

Segregation -- Separating people, such as by race, into different groups

Elvis Presley -- Leading rock and roll singer, famous for hip action

Beat Generation -- Young people who rejected the establishment/social norms

Beatniks -- Members of the Beat Generation

Fall-Out Shelter -- Location one went to protect themselves from nuclear attack

Sputnik -- First unmanned satellite sent into space

Cosmonaut -- Russian astronaut

UNIVAC -- Universal Automatic Computer; First general use business computer

Affluent Society -- Term, sometimes critical, for U.S. economic prosperity

Hula Hoop -- A plastic hoop that could be spun around your waist



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
