Thank-you for visiting my site; I hope you love this resource! It works well as a review, homework or sub lesson.

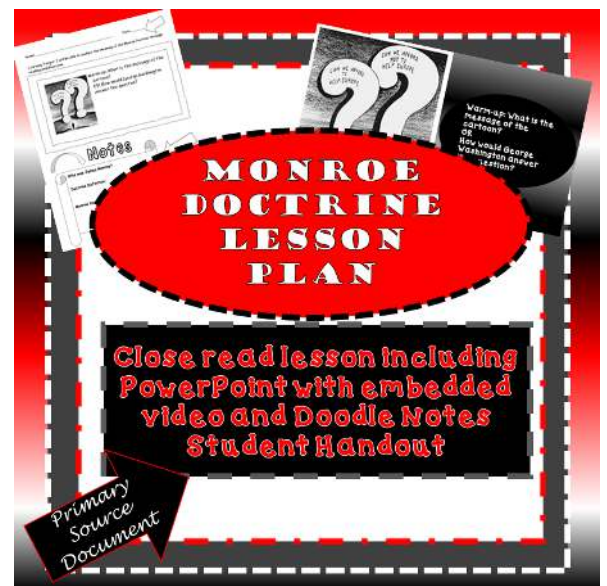
Usage Guide:
