Woodrow Wilson - President during WWI

Neutrality -- Not taking part in an armed conflict; U.S. was neutral early in WWI

Lusitania -- British Ocean Liner sunk by Germans, killing over 100 U.S. citizens

U Boat -- German submarine

Zimmerman Telegram -- German diplomatic message planning to gain Mexican alliance

Allied Powers -- United Kingdom, France and others who fought with U.S.

Central Powers -- Germany, Austria-Hungary and others who fought against the U.S.

Espionage Act -- 1917 federal law dealing with attempts to interfere with war efforts

Conscientious Objectors -- Those with moral/religious opposition to fighting in wars

Conscription -- Mandatory draft of people to fight or provide other services in a war

Western Front -- Main theater of World War 1, located in Western Europe

Doughboy - The nickname for US soldiers in World War I

Fourteen Points -- Wilson speech discussing U.S. war aims, including long term peace

Armistice Day -- November 11, 1918; ending of hostilities

Versailles Treaty -- Peace treaty to formally end WWI; U.S. did not ratify

League of Nations -- International association of nations formed after WWI

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
