- Fort Sumter -- Location of first battle of the Civil War
- Bull Run -- Important early battle suggesting war would not be quick
- McClellan -- Early commander of Union Army of Potomac
- Robert E Lee -- Commander of Confederate Army of Virginia
- Shiloh -- Bloody western battle showing horrors of the war
- Blockade -- Act of sealing off area to prevent goods from entering/leaving
- Ironclads -- Steam powered ships protected by iron/steel plates
- Vicksburg -- Site of a major siege/battle leading to Union control of Mississippi River
- Gettysburg -- Major battle in Pennsylvania; site of famous Lincoln speech
- Ulysses S Grant -- Western general later commander of Union forces
- Appomattox -- Location of final major battle of the Civil War
